

When completing the Application Form for Compensation for Victims of WWII Transport by NS, the Committee wants to save you the trouble of having to include a large number of documents, insofar as possible. Therefore, where possible, the Application Form contains statements for you to tick. Below are the documents the Committee does ask you to include, depending on – among other things – what type of applicant you are.

¹ **How can I use the KopieID app to make a safe copy of my identity document?**

The KopieID app allows you to use your mobile phone or tablet to make a safe copy of your identity document (ID document).

² **You can request an extract from the Personal Records Database (Basisregistratie Personen – BRP) from the municipality in which you reside and are registered.**

The standard BRP extract will state that you are registered in the municipality's Personal Records Database.

In addition, we ask that you also include the above additional information that, at your request, the municipality will add to the BRP extract.

If you are based outside the Netherlands please upload an equivalent of this document, being a formal confirmation of your personal data as well as your family relationship to the stakeholder.

You are strongly advised to black out all the information provided on the document that is not required for your application.

Note: in some municipalities, some of the 'additional information' we require is part of the standard BRP extract!
